ORDINANCE 2012-52

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 2012
APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, appropriations must be increased in the Permissive Fund 2101 in order to make road improvements including work on Franklin and High Streets and to fulfill the Village's road salt purchase agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1. Council does hereby authorize the following adjustment to the 2012 Village Appropriations:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to permit payment of the Village's expenses in a timely manner, to avoid permitting expenditures to exceed appropriations and to maintain correct accounting practices, and for that reason this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage by the Council.
