RESOLUTION 2025-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2026, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mantua hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Village of Mantua hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Village of Mantua hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Village of Mantua; and
- c. The Village of Mantua agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees that each party hereto shall be responsible for liability associated with that party's own errors, actions, and failures to act.
- d. The Village of Mantua's electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Village of Mantua agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Village of Mantua hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 85% of its electronically submitted salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
- f. The Village of Mantua hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
- g. The Village of Mantua acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, May 1, by 5:00 p.m. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.PurchasingPdot.ohio.Roy by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will

respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Village of Mantua's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Village of Mantua to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Village of Mantua's participation agreement and/or a Village of Mantua's request to rescind its participation agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mantua that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Village of Mantua agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT salt contract.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council, in order to submit the required participation documents to the ODOT.
