Approval of the Minutes for previous month

Mayor also told Greg that the service department will need to pull the decoration for the tree that needs put up in the lodge. Also the mini park needs decorated. Heather asked if we could asked Buckeye to sign the Ohio Edison agreement. Scott and Mayor explained why not.
- Mayor Clark mentioned that the AT&T refund has been approved internally, but ATT couldn't give us a dollar amount yet.
- Tammy Meyer mentioned talking to CT and agreeing to keeping it at 75 hours and review after the 6-month contract and see if we need to change anything then sign the 3-year contract.
